PROHIBITION OF LOITERING AND WANDERING IN ANY AREAS IN JOHOR PORT BERHAD (JPB) FOR VESSEL AND BOAT CREWS.

The above subject matter is kindly referred.

As you are all fully aware that we are the OHSAS 1800:2007 international standard certified organization, which requires us to maintain and continuously improve on Occupational Safety and Health ("OSH") at our workplace within JPB premises.

It has been "JPB"'s culture that we practiced the ALARP (as far as practically practicable) to maintain the safety and wellness of port users within our premises at all time. Thereby I wish to remind all port users (staff, tenants and leases, customers, contractors, visitors, suppliers, government agencies, regulatory bodies and other stakeholders) that it is mandatory for ALL who enter JPB operations areas and workplace to observe and comply strictly to the safety rules and regulations.

I wish to remind any vessel and boat crews are strictly prohibited from loitering and wandering in any areas in JPB without permission. If there is any urgency to go onshore (JPB areas etc), the usage of PPE (personal protective equipment); safety shoe, safety helmet, long pants, shirt and safety vest is mandatory. Agent is highly recommended to ferry crews for any movement in JPB.

As for the shore leave application, vessel and boat crews must get the approval from Immigration Department of Malaysia through the appointed agent and to fill up declaration form at JPB Check Point. Non -local crews must come back to JPB by 11.59 pm on the same day.

JPB reserves the right to take necessary action if found fail to comply with any requirements stipulated. Therefore your understanding, continuous support and usual co-operations are duly appreciated to ensure a safe working place and conducive environment for everyone.
