As for Halal Logistics, we opined that factors such as equipment, packaging and handling of cargo to comply and qualify for halal status will be very costly and any implementation will require a clear SOP.</p> <p>2) <u>JPB – Presentation of DGC Implementation on 27/8/2020</u> The charges will take effect from 1st October 2020.</p> <p>3) <u>JKDM Meeting on Levi Kenderaan on 30/8/2020</u> Attended meeting with VP. To-date not many issues on levy payments after the soft launching 2 weeks ago. To sum up, problems faced in the process of implementation of debit card lies solely with RHB.</p> <p>4) <u>MITI – Seminar on Industry 4WRD Incentives on 3/9/20</u> Above function represented by Ms Hau.</p> <p>5) <u>JKDM Meeting with Acting Customs Johor on 21/9/2020</u> Meeting with Tuan Sazali Mohamad. Issues highlighted by JPSFA as follows: -</p> <p>a) Hanging Forms</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Notice of hanging forms sent by JKDM by normal mail is slow and risky. Requested for UKA to send notices via email. JPSFA will forward the email addresses of agents under JPSFA to Puan Fatimah for her record. - Mostly involving K3 to East Malaysia whereby goods are taken but not released in the system. Agents have been advised to check with UKA on contradictory information between SMK front end and Customs. On this note, JPSFA is encouraged to write to the DG for a representation at the Custom Consultative Meeting to bring forth issues that concern stakeholders in the Southern Region. - Customs may block the forwarding agents for failure to comply in clearing the hanging forms. UKA gave assurance that they will call agents before blocking their clearance operations. <p>b) Audit PASCA Import</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Audit by Customs found that the value of insurance and freight were not indicated in the K1 form for CIF shipments. Ms Stephanie explained that it was mentioned in a previous briefing that there is no need for an estimate as taxable value is based on the CIF amount. Also, some audit officers have insisted for original FTA forms although the customers were only able to produce endorsed photocopies since the originals were mandatorily surrendered to Customs for clearance. Tuan Sazali informed that he will look into this and investigate further on these issues. <p>6) <u>JPB – Meeting on new rules implemented in CEA on 22/9/20</u> It was agreed JPB will not allow side loaders in CEA area. Port Safety will have the right to compound to a maximum of RM500 for any containers not properly parked at CEA.
