





Roles of Punctuation in HS

SEMI-COLON (;)

- 1) It is used to indicate a full-stop.
- A good or list of goods separated by semi-colons must be treated as distinct and separate from each other when considering tariff classification at the heading or subheading level.

Example:

83.06 - Bells, gongs and the like, nonelectric, of base metal ; statuettes and other ornaments, of base metal ; photograph, picture or similar frames, of base metal; mirrors of base metal.

COLON (:)

- It is used to indicate that <u>further subdivisions</u> will occur.
- 2) The colons appear after the end of every subheading text which has **further breakdowns**.

Example:

01.04 Live sheep and goats.

0104.10 - Sheep :

0104.10.10 - - Pure-bred breeding animals

0104.10.90 -- Other 0104.20 - Goats:

COMMA (,)

- It is used to separate items or list of goods described in the heading & subheading texts.
- It is used to separate the list of items from the descriptor phrase or from a series of descriptors to which the items belong.

Example 1 : To separate the list of items

84.29 - Self-propelled bulldozers , angle dozers , graders , levellers , scrapers , mechanical shovels , excavators , shovel loaders , tamping machines and road rollers

Example 2 : A series of descriptors

72.21 - Bars and rods , hot-rolled , in irregularly wound coils , of stainless steel .

PERIOD (.)

- 1) It is used to indicate a full stop in the heading text which means **only** those products mentioned are included and nothing more.
- The period indicates the <u>end of the descriptive</u> <u>text</u> of the heading. Only those article described therein can be classified under the term of that heading.

Example:

42.03 - Articles of apparel and clothing accessories, of leather or of composition leather <u>.</u>



SCOPE of LEGAL NOTES in HS

1. Legal Notes on EXCLUSION *

- To exclude certain goods from the Section or Chapter.

Example: Chapter Note 1 to Chapter 84

- 1. This Chapter does not cover:
- a) Millstones, grindstones or other articles of Chapter 68;

3. Legal Notes on **DEFINITION**

To define a paper that can be considered a newsprint.

Example:

Chapter Note 4 to Chapter 48

4. In this Chapter the expression "newsprint" means uncoated paper.

2. Legal Notes on SCOPE

- To determine the scope of the Section or Chapter

Example: Chapter Note 1 to Chapter 1

1. This Chapter covers all live animals

except —

- a) Fish and crustaceans, molluscs and other aquatic invertebrates of heading 03.01, 03.06 or 03.07 or 30.08;
- b) Cultures of micro organisms and other products of heading 30.02; and
- c) Animals of heading 95.08

4. Legal Notes on

NATIONAL NOTE

- To clarify & define the terms or texts in the national line as required.

Example:

- a) Terms of Infant (heading 04.02)
- b) Children Bicycle (heading 87.12)

General Rules of Interpretation (GIRs)

- The titles of Sections, Chapters & sub-Chapters are provided for ease of reference only; for legal purposes.
- For classification purposes, all section notes, chapter notes, subheading notes & text of the heading have to be referred.

Example:

Live Horse (01.01) Horses for travelling circuses (95.08)

- 2(a) The good has the essential character but
- (i) Incomplete / unfinished, as presented;
- (ii) Presented in unassembled / disassembled





- Name & Description of the good;
- Material Composition/ Components;
- > Size & Dimension;
- Function/Application;
- Mechanism of the good;
- Manufacturing Process;
- Installation Method;
- Packaging of good.

(AHTN)

What is AHTN?

The ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) is an eight-digit HS-based commodity nomenclature common among the 10 ASEAN Member States. Philippine Subheading. Beyond the 8-digit AHTN level, the Philippines assigns alpha-numeric codes to provide for its national tariff lines.

Developed by the ASEAN member states in ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2003. 02

Goal is to move towards a single uniform tariff nomenclature that would contribute significantly to transparency in tariff classification and trade facilitation. 03



SARONG OF A TUBULAR TYPE

Sarong (also known as *Malong* or *Longyi*) is a garment made of a woven fabric whose edges are sewn together to form a pipe or tube. The not-stitched edges are formed of self-edges. Generally, Sarong is worn wrapped around the waist to cover lower body (waist downwards). Sarong can be worn by both men and women, and therefore it is included here in accordance with Note 8 to Chapter 62.p

THREE-WHEELED VEHICLES								

These vehicles have mechanical characteristics similar to that of conventional motor cars, i.e., they are fitted with a compression-ignition internal combustion piston engine (diesel or semi-diesel) or a spark-ignition internal combustion piston engine **AND** fitted with the reverse gear and a differential. However, they are not fitted with motor car type steering wheels.

They are usually presented with a bench-type seat at the rear-end of the vehicle and are used for transportation of persons. Passengers' area is separated from that of the driver.




National Lines in PDK 2022

National notes is an opportunity to influence the classification of goods (by using additional notes to define certain terms or products better or to define special methods for analyzing certain goods) and thereby, to influence the classification of imported or exported goods

CHAPTER 21

Miscellaneous edible preparations



For the purpose of subheading 2106.90.96 00 the term "medical foods" means foods that are specially formulated and intended for the dietary management of a disease that has distinctive nutritional needs that cannot be met by normal diet alone. Medical foods are distinct from the broader category of foods for special dietary use and from traditional foods that bear a health claim. In order to be considered a medical food the product must, at a minimum:

- (i) be a food for oral ingestion or tube feeding (nasogastric tube);
- (ii) be labelled for the dietary management of a specific medical disorder, disease or condition for which there are distinctive nutritional requirements; and
- (iii) be intended to be used under medical supervision.


