All personnel involved in the transportation of dangerous goods be sea. Preferably Executives and above

The **IMDG Code: General Awareness** is is the 1st step towards competency and certification for all shore-based personnel involved in the transportation of packaged dangerous goods by sea. Amplified in the SOLAS Chapter VII and MARPOL Annex III, all packaged dangerous goods intended for sea transportation has to be in compliance of the IMDG Code.

The **IMDG Code in Part 1.3** states the mandatory requirement for training and certification by the National Competent Authority (NCA), for all Shore-Based personnel involved the transport of in dangerous by sea. The NCA in Malaysia and certification body is the Malaysian Marine Department.
